

# GO Groups vs Class Groups Overview



There are **two** different types of groups you can set up with your class. A **'GO Group'** and a **'Class Group'**. Each of these groups offer different functionalities.

## Functionalities

### Class Group

**Group check-ins:** Typically used by class groups that will participate in a facilitated check-in process at agreed or scheduled times.

**Check-in session stats:** Results from the most recent check-in session for the class aggregated and sorted by emotion, with supporting summary graphs on the distribution of emotion and energy levels.

**Request for chat notification sent at the end of the check-in session:** If a student completes a check-in requesting a follow up conversation, an email and push notification (when using the iOS app) is sent once the check-in session is closed to selected educators.

**Longitudinal check-in data for the class:** In addition to providing a summary of the most recent check-in session, there is visibility of all check-ins for the class sorted by the last 7 days, 4 weeks or year to date.

### GO Group

**Individual check-ins:** Typically used by Guidance Officer type roles that are more likely to facilitate check-ins on an ad hoc basis (between 8:00am and 4:00pm) with individuals either in person or remotely.

**Check-in stats:** Results from the most recent check-in for each individual aggregated and sorted by emotion.

**Request for chat notification sent immediately:** If a student completes a check-in requesting a follow up conversation, an email alert and push notification (when using the iOS app) is sent immediately to selected educators.

**Aggregated check-in data for individuals:** Individual check-in data collected via both GO Group and Class Groups that a student is assigned to is aggregated into a combined longitudinal view.

# GO Groups vs Class Groups Stats pages



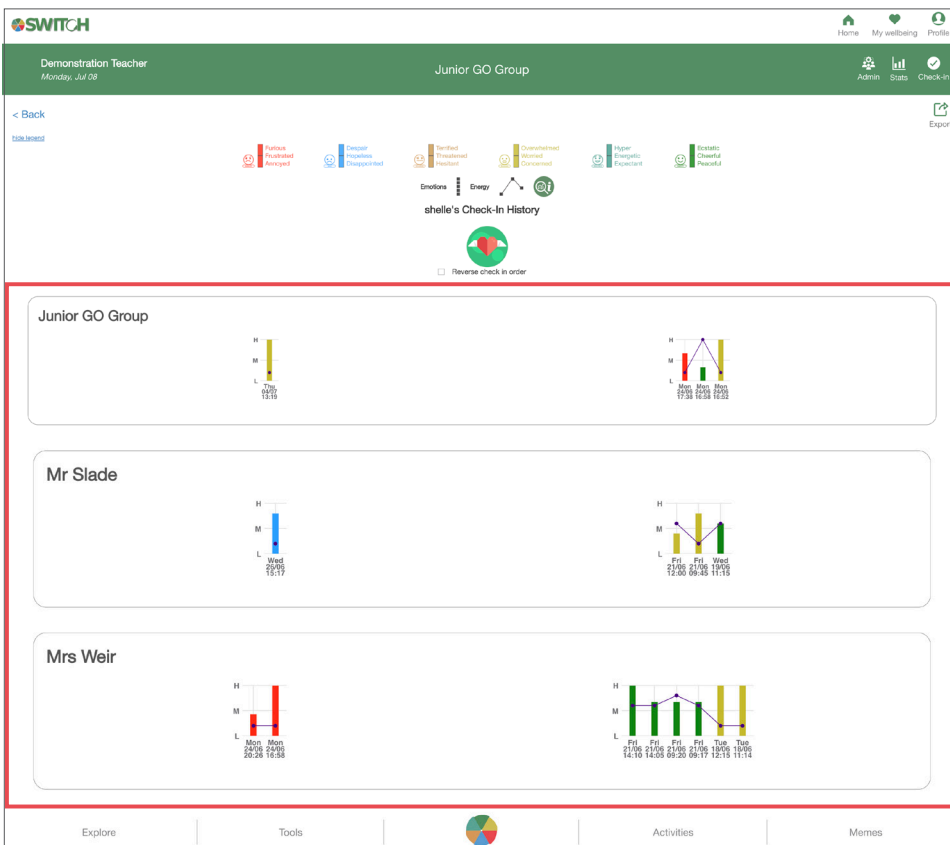
Teachers are able to see an aggregate view of their student's **individual stats** in both Class groups and GO groups. However, depending on which you are in, the layout will be **different**. The same is true for student view if you have enabled that functionality.

## Class group stats



In class groups, the data that you see in the 'individual student stats' section will only be connected to the class you are currently in.

## GO group stats



In GO groups, the data that you see in the 'individual student stats' section will have an aggregate view of that student's stats across all of the classes they are assigned to.
